Veterans' House Canada

Veterans' House Canada is a federally incorporated and registered charity #791683469RR0001 based in Ottawa. Our mission is to help homeless Veterans build a better future by providing **permanent**, affordable, and supportive housing. Currently, there are an estimated 3,000 to 5,000 homeless Veterans across Canada, including Indigenous Veterans, many of whom are living with mental health concerns, addiction issues, and physical disabilities. Veterans' House Canada provides a unique Veterans-only setting with access to support programs, counselling, and peer mentoring to address the root causes of homelessness facilitated by a dedicated Mental Health Specialist and Program Facilitator.

We are excited to announce that Veterans' House Canada will be building our second home in Edmonton, Alberta. The Edmonton City Council Executive Committee approved the sale of a 1.46-acre parcel of land to us in Athlone, North-West Edmonton, on December 6th, 2023. Construction is anticipated to begin in early 2025 and the project completion date in 2026. The new building, similar to our Ottawa home, will feature 40 bachelor units, along with amenities such as a social room, fitness room, library, park with a covered barbecue area, community garden, meditation park, and a dog park. Our first home The Andy Carswell building opened on February 1st, 2021, with the help of funds from various sources including federal, provincial, municipal government, and private sectors. We raised \$11.5M. The next cities under consideration for more homes include Halifax, Montreal, Toronto, Winnipeg, Vancouver and Victoria.

The projected cost for this project is approximately \$16M. To bridge the funding gap, Veterans' House Canada is launching an Alberta Capital Campaign to raise \$6M in private donations for the new home in Edmonton. Veterans' House Canada has already secured a private funding commitment of at least \$1 million from Canso Investment Counsel Ltd.

The official groundbreaking ceremony is anticipated to take place in 2025, with the presence of government officials and private donors.

Our heroes served and put their lives on the line, it is unacceptable that any Veteran should find themselves homeless.



Veterans' House Edmonton will feature a 3-storey, 40-unit apartment building that will provide permanent, affordable and supportive housing for homeless Veterans. The building has been specifically designed to meet the needs of Veterans. Full accessibility is provided for 20% of the units and all common amenity spaces, while the remaining suites are 'visitable'.

Communal spaces including a multipurpose room, a fitness room, a laundry room, a library, and a shared kitchen are provided to promote community engagement and healthy living. A calming outdoor space includes a meditation garden, a covered barbecue patio, a vegetable garden, and a fenced dog park. Shared offices in the building provide support services for the Veterans as they adjust to civilian life.




